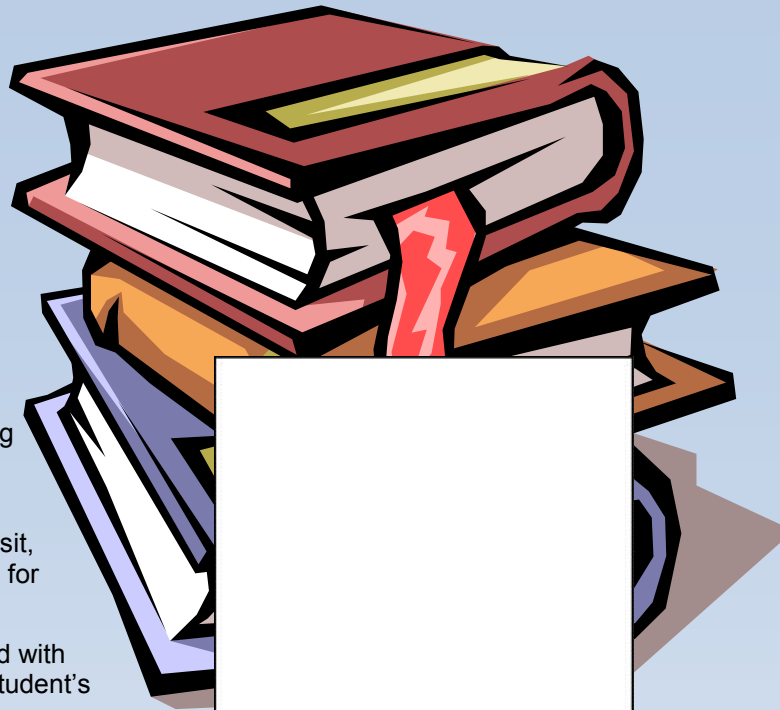


St. Clair County K-6 Clean Air & Healthy Living BOOKMARK CONTEST
